Additional Notes for Vendors

1. Payment for Sales by cheque

Those of you that are due a payment by cheque, (which will apply to all that have sold lots for a sum in excess of £50 and others that are used to being paid by cheque or are unable to collect cash payments) should please note that payments will be made **three weeks** from the date of the auction to allow the auction cashier to get cheques to the bank and for them to be cleared into the society bank account.
